Corfu Sea School is happy to provide qualified Instructors to teach the RYA syllabus on our client's own boats. However, the boats must be in good condition, fully seaworthy and have the following equipment:

Life raft	With coastal or inshore pack, of a size suitable for number of persons aboard yacht.
First Aid Kit	
Lifejackets	1 for each person aboard, of an approved type
Safety Harnesses	As above
Flares	2 red parachute rockets, 2 orange floating smoke, 4 red hand flares. All to be in date
Man Overboard recovery equipment	Horseshoe lifebuoy with light
Fire Fighting Equipment	1 dry powder extinguisher for each sleeping cabin plus 1 for the cockpit and 1 for the engine compartment. Fire blanket for the galley. All in date and serviced.

Bilge Pump	
Bolt Croppers	
Buckets	2
2 <sup>nd</sup> Anchor and Warp	
GPS	Handheld or fitted
VHF Radio	Marine band
Charts of the Area	
Pilot Book of the Area	
Tool Kit	With tools suitable for engine and rigging
Engine Spares	Impeller, fuel filter, alternator belt
Navigation Lights	Port, Starboard, Stern and Steaming
Torches	At least 2
General spares	Shackles, nuts and bolts etc.
Storm canvas	Method for reefing both mainsail and genoa

It is also advisable to check the boat over before your Instructor arrives, especially if it has not been used for some time. Check the engine, rigging and sails to ensure they are all working properly.

Finally, please note that it is your responsibility to ensure that the boat is fully insured and that the ship's papers (including registration documents, life raft and fire extinguisher certificates and radio licences) are all onboard, correct and in a form acceptable to the Greek Port Police.
