# Morley

### Description

Morley is a large market town with mainline rail and road links. The harbour offers good all round shelter.

Most pleasure craft opt to berth at Shirley Marina in the NE corner of the harbour, although good holding and protection can be found two cables south of the isolated danger mark to the NW of the dredged channel (8m) that runs to the marina.

## Approach

From the West the approach between Tetyana Island and the mainland is made from close to the safe water mark. A good transit from there on is the CG building on the eastern shore in line with the LH (Iso6sWRG).

From the East vessels need to past beneath the road bridge connecting Tetyana Island with the mainland. Care is need as the north shore has been silting over recent years. Passage beneath the bridge is controlled by Morley HM (VHF channel 12).

#### Speed limits

There is a 7 knot speed limit within the harbour.
